Fire protection and modernization

Johannes-Wagner-Schule is a state school for hearing and speech impaired students, which includes boarding facilities. It is located on the outskirts of Nürtingen, heading towards Neuffen. The architecturally demanding buildings of reinforced concrete solid construction with structured exposed concrete elements were built between 1972 and 1976 and incorporated many design details.

Bohle Innenausbau GmbH & Co. KG, Stuttgart performed work mostly to remove fire and safety deficiencies. Within the framework of this construction phase, the secondary school was renovated.

Specifically fire water lines and tanks were clad with Promat slabs. For this purpose, wall cladding had to be removed and reinstalled. In corridors and on staircases, cable trays were clad with drywall panels. Underneath this cladding acoustic elements by Ecophon were provided as a suspended installation. On the ground floor, outside walls were clad from the inside with a sheet and provided with insulation material.
